

## Travel Scholarship

### Background

The 2015 AGM passed a motion that the AGA spend \$1,200 on travel scholarships to encourage players from around the country to participate in the 2016 National Championships.

### Process

The AGA will provide travel scholarships to five different people from five states/areas of Australia for the 2016 National Championships (this excludes people from Victoria who are hosting the AGA National Championships).

The five scholarships will be of \$250 each and paid only to a person who is attending the 2016 Nationals (preferably supplying a receipt for their air flight as proof and early registration).

For 2016 the states/areas are:

- NSW & ACT – submissions from clubs
- Queensland – submissions from clubs/society
- Western Australia – coordinated by Clive Hunt
- South Australian – Personal applications
- Tasmania & The Northern Territory – Personal applications

Each club in each state/area will nominate one person for a scholarship which must be sent to the AGA Secretary (Secretary@AustralianGo.asn.au) by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2016 and include the reasons why that person should be selected.

Players in South Australia, Tasmania and The Northern Territory must submit their own applications because there is no club or AGA representative in those states.

The AGA committee will select one candidate from each state and the secretary will notify the winning candidates within one week of the decision being made.

The AGA Committee's decision in this matter final and no correspondence will be entered into.
