The entry fee includes refreshments and lunch which will be available around midday. Because of the time constraint there is no single official break for lunch, people are requested to eat lunch as and when they can.


Registration closes at 5:00pm, Saturday 16th March and **if you have not registered you cannot play.**

Divisions:

Division A:	5D and over (no handicap; komi 6.5 points); 4 rounds	Maximum of 16 players
Division B:	5D to 1k (handicap)* 5 rounds	
Division C:	1k and below (handicap)* 5 rounds	
Division D:	Junior player handicap*. (For people under 16 years of age). 6 rounds**	

*Maximum handicap is 9 stone.

**The number of rounds may be reduced if there are less than 7 entries.

Tournament format for Division A - 4 rounds: Rounds: Swiss draw; 4 rounds for each division Time Limit: 20 minutes + 30 seconds, 3 times This assumes a round lasts no more than 90 minutes: Any games not finished within 85 minutes will be adjudicated. Timetable for 4 rounds 9:00am Doors open – people register with the club and enter the room. 9:30am – Round 1 11:15pm – Round 2 12:45pm – Round 3 2:15pm – Break 2:30pm – Round 4 4:30pm – Prizes Tournament format for Division B & C - 5 rounds: Rounds: Swiss draw; 5 rounds for each division Time Limit: 20 minutes + 30 seconds, 3 times This assumes a round lasts no more than 70 minutes: Any games not finished within 65 minutes will be adjudicated. Timetable for 5 rounds 9:00am Doors open – people register with the club and enter the room. 9:30am – Round 1 11:00am – Round 2 12:10pm – Round 3 1:20pm – Round 4 2:30pm – Round 5 4:30pm – Prizes

Tournament format for Division D - 6 rounds:

Rounds: Swiss draw; 6 rounds for each division

Time Limit: 15 minutes + 20 seconds, 3 times

This assumes a round lasts no more than 50 minutes: Any games not finished within 55 minutes will be adjudicated.

Timetable for 6 rounds

9:00am Doors open – people register with the club and enter the room. 9:30am – Round 1 10:30am – Round 2 11:30pm – Round 3 12:30pm – Round 4 1:30pm – Round 5 2:30pm – Round 6 4:30pm – Prizes

Tournament management:

The Tournament Director is Gareth White; The Tournament referee is An Younggil 8P.

Game adjudication & dispute process:

The event must adhere to a tight timetable, games lasting longer than 85 minutes will be adjudicated by the Tournament Referee (using AI technology if appropriate). In the event of a dispute, the Tournament Referee and Tournament Director will decide the matter, their decision is final.

Refreshment:

Refreshment including a light lunch will be provided as part of the entry fee. Unfortunately, no provision can be made for people with special dietary needs.

As mentioned above, we have limited time, so there is no single official break for lunch, people are requested to each lunch as and when they can. Also, please be mindful of players who may not have had eaten yet!

Prizes:

There will be trophies for the first three places in each of the main divisions, with medals and certificates for the junior division.
