The 2025 Quzhou Lanke International Child Friendly Weiqi Championship was held between $23^{rd} \sim 27^{th}$ Oct 2025 in Quzhou, China. The tournament was held over 4 days with players from around the world competing.

The Australian team representatives were:

- Leo Chen, 7 kyu (9 years) and
- William Hu, 10 kyu (9 years).

This was their first time at a large-scale international tournament, so they were a bit nervous. Most of the players from around the world were teenagers and ranked well above the Australian team and with all games played even (no handicap) it was not surprising we lost some games. Having said that, all three players played competitive matches and came close to winning in many games.

The Australia won the Australia vs Quzhou International match. That team included three international players training in Quzhou with ranks of 4d, 1d and 3k much higher than us. A fantastic result!

All three Australian children learned a lot and had some amazing experiences playing Go and meeting players from around the world. The children should be commended on the fearless way they played, even when facing with high Dan players.

The event was very friendly with children from different countries sitting together and reviewing the games and learning from each other.
