Details

The Hahn Memorial tournament celebrating the life and achievements of Hahn Sang Dae will be held at ‘the school’ building next to the Gordon Library, 799 Pacific Highway, Gordon. Doors open at 9:00am with the tournament starting at 9:30am.

There will be a single McMahon tournament for the adults with prizes for the Open, Dan & kyu handicap. The junior DDK tournament will be a separate event.

Divisions:

Adult divisions	There will be 4 rounds with three prize divisions – The Hahn Open (5D and above, even games); The Hahn Dan (even games), and Hahn Kyu handicap. NOTE: The split of divisions will be determined on the day depending on the number of people who join the event.
Junior division	There will be 5 rounds for people under 16 years of age with ranks from beginner to 15 kyu.

Main Division Tournament format:

Rounds: 4 rounds, McMahon draw.

Time Limit: 20 minutes + 30 seconds, 3 times

Any games not finished within 85 minutes will be adjudicated.

Junior Tournament format:

Rounds: Swiss draw; 5 rounds for each division

Time Limit: 15 minutes + 20 seconds, 3 times
games not finished within 60 minutes will be adjudicated.

Game adjudication & dispute process:

The event must adhere to a tight timetable, games lasting longer than 85 minutes will be adjudicated by the Tournament Referee (using AI technology if appropriate). In the event of a dispute, the Tournament Referee and Tournament Director will decide the matter, their decision is final.

Refreshment:

Refreshment including a light lunch and soft drinks will be provided as part of the entry fee. Unfortunately, no provision can be made for people with special dietary needs.

Prizes:

There will be trophies for the first three places in the Open division and medals and certificates for the Dan, Kyu handicap and juniors.
